

CORNHOLE TOURNAMENT RULES

This is a fundraising event to help benefit a local, competitive cheerleading team and expenses associated with registration, uniforms, and tournament costs.

The tournament will accept team/individual registrations until 3:15pm on Saturday, April 27.

The tournament will host two divisions: Adult Division (18 y/o+) and Junior Division (17-12 y/o & 12 y/o & under)

Each team will consist of two (2) players. May sign up individually*

The cost to enter is:

Adult Division - \$75 pre-register (mail-in or online) and \$100 on site/day of event

Junior Division - \$35 pre-register (mail-in or online) and \$50 on site/day of event

*Individual cost is \$50/Adult and \$25/Junior

The tournament will be played rain or shine and decision to cancel due to inclement weather is up to the tournament host, Dogwood Charity Partners.

The tournament will be played at The Southern Brewing Company, located at 231 Collins Ind Blvd, Athens, GA 30601

The tournament will be played according to the American Cornhole Association official rules. These can be found at: <https://www.playcornhole.org/pages/rules>

All boards and bags will adhere to the ACA dimensions. Teams may bring their own bags and boards, but will be subject to inspection prior to entry of play.

Tournament registration is currently open for mail-in and online registration.

Day of event registration will be on Saturday, April 27 beginning at 2:30pm at SBC.

Play will begin PROMPTLY at 3:30pm.

Once registration is closed, each team will draw a number, 1 through amount of teams entered to play, from a hat, that will assign them a team number.

Teams will be written into a bracket to assign play.

Each "round" will be a best 2-out-of-3 play, with each game being the first to 21.

All tournament games will be scored using traditional cancellation scoring format. In cancellation scoring, in each inning after all 8 bags are thrown the low score (bags on the board, and in the hole) is subtracted from the high score to determine points scored in that inning. Example: Thrower "A" has one bag in the hole (3 points), two on the board surface (2 points) and one bag off the board (zero points) for a total of 5 points. Thrower "B" has two in the hole (6 points) and two on the board (two points) for a total of 8 points. The score after this inning is TEAM B = 3 and TEAM A = 0

Each round will be limited to 30 minutes of play. If, at the end of the time limit, no winner has been determined, the team with the most cumulative points from that round will be declared the winner.

Games will be self scored by participants. Disputes will be resolved quickly by tournament officials.

Rulings by tournament officials are final, no exceptions.

Awards will be given to the top 1st and 2nd place teams in the Adult and each of the Junior divisions.
